Notice is hereby given to the general public that the Sonoita-Elgin Fire District (SEFD) Board of Directors (SEFD is governed by a five-member Board pursuant to A.R.S. §48-803.B) will hold a meeting on Monday, August 24, 2020. The meeting will be held at the SEFD fire station, located at 3173 N. Highway 83, Sonoita, AZ. The meeting is open to the general public and will begin at 9: am. local time.

The following agenda items are scheduled for consideration by the SEFD Board of Directors at the board meeting. Action or decisions may or may not be taken on any or all items. Agenda items may or may not be considered in the order listed:

Call to the Public. Limited to 3 minutes

A public body may make an open call to the public during a public meeting, subject to reasonable time, place and manner restrictions, to allow individuals to address the public body on any issue within the jurisdiction of the public body. At the conclusion of an open call to the public, individual members of the public body may respond to criticism made by those who have addressed the public body, may ask staff to review a matter or may ask that a matter be put on a future agenda. However, members of the public body shall not discuss or take legal action on matters raised during an open call to the public unless the matters are properly noticed for discussion and legal action.

- **5)** Update Elections cancellation of elections Chief/Admin(We should receive the official notice of the ability to cancel the elections before the end of the month. This is a technicality and may or may not arrive prior to the August Board meeting. Not an issue to discuss or approve, just a point of fact. Admin)
- 6) Discussion and possible action on the review and handling of letters received from members of the public expressing concern related to various District issues. Johnson
- 7) Discussion and possible action on the appointment of Jon Buonaccorsi as Acting Chief for the duration of Chief DeWolf's medical leave; discussion and possible action on the associated compensation in the position of Acting Chief. The Board may choose to go into executive session. Notice: pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.03(A)(1), discussion or consideration of employment, assignment, appointment, promotion, demotion, dismissal, salaries, disciplining or resignation of a public officer, appointee or employee of any public body, except that, with the exception of salary discussions, an officer, appointee or employee may demand that the discussion or consideration occur at a public meeting. The public body shall provide the officer, appointee or employee with written notice of the executive session as is appropriate but not less than twenty-four hours for the officer, appointee or employee to determine whether the discussion or consideration should occur at a public meeting.
