Review and approval of the governing board meeting minutes of Nov 20, 27, 2017 and November 27: 2017: Motion to approve minutes from Nov. 20, 2017 made by Archibald, seconded by Johnson, motion carried unanimously. Motion by Archibald to accept the minutes to the Nov 27, 2017 minutes, seconded by Johnson, motion carried unanimously.

Report from the Fire Chief – Chief reported on the monthly statistics for SEFD, call load and types of runs, simultaneous calls and events participated in; updated the Board on reimbursements for wildland fires; progress report on Palominas Fire District and the IGA; California fires & information on our crews, and the Community Pot Luck held by Judge Barth for the Corrections Personnel who help in our Community.

Call to the Public. -There were no participants.

Monthly financial reports and consideration of district financial matters: Presented by Rutter; there were no unusual events to report, we're collecting the first half of our taxes – we're right on track. Donations are up considerably. There was brief updates on PSPRS, Fuels Grant, and the new Vehicle to replace 830. Cash Flow Forecast (cash in and cash out on a monthly basis) was presented as well. Chief – we can post it, we'll just have to stay on topic and state that no decisions will be made at this meeting. The discussion ran on for several minutes, no formal decisions were made. There would be more discussion at the January meeting.
